



## **YOUTH SPEAKER BIO**

Tim Snow, Winnisquam High School (Tilton, NH), Offensive Coordinator

Coach Snow has been coaching football at different levels since 1990. As OC, at Winnisquam, Snow introduced an offensive system that led to an undefeated season in 2015, the first time ever in the school's history. That offensive squad also led the division in rushing and passing yards, as well as touchdowns. Snow has also served as the offensive and defensive lines coach, the president of the booster club, and the primary field painter! Coach Snow previously served as President of Team NH in the Football University National Tournament, as well as the head coach of the teams for 5 years; and was selected to coach for Team NH in the 2018 NH/VT Shrine Maple Game for the Dartmouth Hitchcock Hospital.

Despite the fact that Snow attended a high school that did not have a football program, he played while serving in the US Army overseas. In 1981 and 1982 Snow was selected to play on the US Army NATO All Star Team, and traveled Europe playing different countries professional teams.

Coach Snow also runs a 2 day, full pad football camp in Central NH featuring several former New England Patriots players as instructors, with contact drills and positional scrimmages, with a focus on fundamentals and technique.

Coach Snow has been married to Cherie, a former D1 college field hockey player and current high school field hockey coach, for 20 years. They have 4 children; 2 in college, one of which was a redshirt walk on freshman at UNH, a senior in high school headed to Nichols College next year, and a sophomore in high school. They currently live in Central NH.
